#### NOTICE TO LICENSEES OF CHANGES TO STATUTE GOVERNING PRIVATE POSTSECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

On September 26, 2012, Governor Brown signed into law Assembly Bill 2296, Chapter 585, Statutes of 2012. As a result of the passage of this legislation, institutions governed by the California Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009 (Act) will be required to make several changes to the information disclosed to prospective students and the data provided to the Bureau. This courtesy notice is intended to provide a summary of the statutory changes that become effective January 1, 2013, and the actions your institution should take in order to achieve compliance with the law.

#### **Statement of Accreditation and Federal Financial Aid**

California University of Management and Technology, while working closely with accrediting agency on accreditation, is NOT accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDE). The University does not participate state and federal financial aid programs.

1. Completing a CALMAT degree program does not make the student eligible to sit for applicable licensure exam in California and other states.
2. A degree program that is unaccredited or a degree from an unaccredited institution is not recognized for some employment positions, including, but not limited to, positions with the State of California.”
3. A student enrolled in an unaccredited institution is not eligible for federal financial aid programs.
